

HOUSE BILL No. 4160

February 2, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Hernandez, Lucido, Canfield, Frederick, Noble, Brann and Sabo and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 676b (MCL 257.676b).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 676b. (1) A person, without authority, shall not block,
2 obstruct, impede, or otherwise interfere with the normal flow of
3 vehicular or pedestrian traffic upon a public street or highway in
4 this state, by means of a barricade, object, or device, or with his
5 or her person. This section ~~shall~~**DOES** not apply to persons
6 maintaining, rearranging, or constructing public utility facilities
7 in or adjacent to a street or highway.

8 **(2) ANY PROVISION OF THE MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE THAT**
9 **PROHIBITS A PERSON FROM STANDING IN A ROADWAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF**
10 **SOLICITING A RIDE, EMPLOYMENT, OR BUSINESS FROM THE OCCUPANT OF ANY**
11 **VEHICLE DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO IS SOLICITING CONTRIBUTIONS**

1 ON BEHALF OF A CHARITABLE OR CIVIC ORGANIZATION DURING DAYLIGHT
2 HOURS, IF THAT PERSON MAINTAINS AT LEAST \$500,000.00 IN LIABILITY
3 INSURANCE. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "CHARITABLE OR CIVIC
4 ORGANIZATION" MEANS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT IS RECOGNIZED BY
5 THIS STATE OR THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT.

6 (3) ~~(2)~~—A person who violates this section is responsible for
7 a civil infraction.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
9 after the date it is enacted into law.
