HOUSE BILL No. 4398

March 22, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Neeley, Elder, Sneller, Ellison, Faris and Jones and referred to the Committee on Education Reform.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled $\,$

"The revised school code,"

by amending section 1233 (MCL 380.1233), as amended by 2016 PA 192.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1233. (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, and subject to section 1233c, the board of a school district or intermediate school board of an intermediate school district shall not permit a teacher who does not hold a valid teaching certificate to teach in a grade or department of the school.
 - (2) The board of a school district or intermediate school board of an intermediate school district shall not allow an individual to serve in a counseling role in the school district or intermediate school district, as the role is defined by the superintendent of public instruction, unless the individual meets 1 or more of the following and the board or intermediate school board
