A bill to amend 1885 PA 152, entitled

"An act to authorize the establishment of facilities for former members of the armed forces of the United States in the state of Michigan; to create funds; and to provide for the promulgation of rules,"

by amending section 10 (MCL 36.10), as added by 2016 PA 562.

- Sec. 10. (1) The board of managers may enter into contracts 2 with an-THE authority under the Michigan veterans' facility authority act, 2016 PA 560, MCL 36.101 TO 36.112, to do 1 or more 3 ANY of the following:
 - (a) Lease, sell, or otherwise convey property to that authority for the development of a veterans' facility. as that term defined in the Michigan veterans' facility authority act.
 - (b) Any other agreement regarding PROVIDE FOR the care or housing of veterans in a Michigan veterans' facility.
