

HOUSE BILL No. 6086

May 29, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Vaupel, Howrylak, Brann, Cochran, Hughes, Noble and Lucido and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 905a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 905A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON**
2 **LICENSED UNDER THIS ACT TO SELL ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON**
3 **OR OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES AT RETAIL SHALL POST IN A CONSPICUOUS**
4 **LOCATION A SIGN INFORMING THE PUBLIC OF THE EFFECTS OF ALCOHOL**
5 **CONSUMPTION DURING PREGNANCY. THE SIGN SHALL CONTAIN THE MESSAGE:**
6 **"PREGNANCY AND ALCOHOL DO NOT MIX. DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES,**
7 **INCLUDING WINE, COOLERS, AND BEER, DURING PREGNANCY CAN CAUSE BIRTH**
8 **DEFECTS." THE COMMISSION SHALL DEVELOP AND FURNISH THE SIGN.**
9 **(2) IF THE PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SELLS ALCOHOLIC**

1 LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES, INSTEAD OF POSTING
2 A SIGN THE PERSON MAY PLACE THE MESSAGE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (1)
3 ON A MENU.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days
5 after the date it is enacted into law.
