

HOUSE BILL No. 6296

September 5, 2018, Introduced by Rep. LaFave and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 358, entitled

"An act to regulate the possession of ferrets; to provide for the licensing of ferrets; to provide for requirements for importation and rabies control procedures for ferrets; to provide for the powers and duties of certain governmental entities; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 8 (MCL 287.898).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 8. A local unit of government by ordinance may establish
2 licensing requirements for ferrets. The ordinance ~~shall~~ **MUST**
3 provide for proof of rabies vaccination, license tags, forms, and
4 procedures as described for dogs ~~pursuant to~~ **UNDER** the dog law of
5 1919, ~~Act No. 339 of the Public Acts of 1919, being sections~~
6 ~~287.261 to 287.290 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.~~ **1919 PA 339, MCL**
7 **287.261 TO 287.290, AS IT EXISTED BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE**
8 **AMENDATORY ACT THAT AMENDED THIS SECTION.**

1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
2 after the date it is enacted into law.

3 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
4 unless Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 6301 (request no.
5 01879'17) of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
