

HOUSE BILL No. 6557

November 29, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Howrylak and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to create and implement a centralized juvenile justice data sharing system; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and agencies; and to address funding for a centralized juvenile justice data sharing system.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Department" means the department of health and human
3 services.

4 (b) "System" means the centralized juvenile justice data
5 sharing system created in section 3.

6 Sec. 3. The department shall develop and implement a
7 centralized juvenile justice data sharing system. This system must
8 be adequately and sustainably funded by the state.

1 Sec. 5. (1) Working in partnership with the juvenile court
2 administrators and stakeholders, the system shall utilize the
3 United States Department of Justice's justice data collection and
4 sharing standards and architecture.

5 (2) The state court administrative office must explore a
6 partnership with the Michigan statistical analysis center at
7 Michigan State University.

8 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
9 date it is enacted into law.
