

# SENATE BILL No. 268

March 23, 2017, Introduced by Senators GREGORY, BOOHER, BIEDA, NOFS,  
CONYERS, ROCCA, HOPGOOD, KNEZEK, YOUNG, HOOD and JOHNSON and  
referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 811aa.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 811AA. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER  
2 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A FUND-RAISING PLATE  
3 RECOGNIZING WOMEN VETERANS. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DESIGN THE  
4 FUND-RAISING PLATES AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION.

5           (2) THE WOMEN VETERANS FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE  
6 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS  
7 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER  
8 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL  
9 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.  
10 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN  
11 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

1           (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY  
2 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING WOMEN VETERANS TO  
3 THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE  
4 WOMEN VETERANS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (2).

5           (4) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE WOMEN  
6 VETERANS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) ON A QUARTERLY BASIS  
7 TO THE MICHIGAN VETERANS' TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 37  
8 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION OF 1963.

9           (5) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE  
10 WOMEN VETERANS FUND FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.

11           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
12 after the date it is enacted into law.
