

SENATE BILL No. 355

May 2, 2017, Introduced by Senators JONES, MACGREGOR, MARLEAU, SCHMIDT, HANSEN, BRANDENBURG, NOFS, HILDENBRAND and EMMONS and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to prohibit municipalities from lowering or raising age requirements provided for in state law; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain local officers and officials; and to provide that certain local ordinances or resolutions are void and unenforceable.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "local
2 government age preemption act".

3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:

4 (a) "Governing body" means the body in which the legislative
5 powers of a municipality are vested.

6 (b) "Municipality" means a county, city, village, or township.

7 Sec. 5. Beginning on the effective date of this act, the
8 governing body of a municipality shall not adopt or enforce an
9 ordinance or resolution that lowers or raises an age requirement

1 provided for in state law.

2 Sec. 7. Any provision in an ordinance or resolution adopted by
3 the governing body of a municipality on or after the effective date
4 of this act that lowers or raises an age requirement provided for
5 in state law is void and unenforceable.

6 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
7 date it is enacted into law.
