

SENATE BILL No. 791

January 30, 2018, Introduced by Senators JONES, BIEDA, HOPGOOD, SCHUITMAKER, HOOD, HORN, COLBECK and GREGORY and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending section 505 (MCL 750.505).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 505. (1) ~~Any~~ EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A
2 person who ~~shall commit any~~ COMMITS AN indictable offense at the
3 common law, ~~for the punishment of which no provision is~~ NOT
4 expressly made by any statute of this state, ~~shall be~~ IS guilty of
5 a felony ~~, punishable by imprisonment in the state prison~~ FOR not
6 more than 5 years or by a fine of not more than \$10,000.00, or
7 both. ~~in the discretion of the court.~~

8 (2) A PERSON WHO COMMITS AN OFFENSE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION
9 (1) THAT CAUSES A BODILY INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON REQUIRING MEDICAL

1 ATTENTION OR MEDICAL CARE IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY
2 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
3 \$25,000.00, OR BOTH.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
5 after the date it is enacted into law.
