

# SENATE BILL No. 807

February 6, 2018, Introduced by Senators KNOLLENBERG, GREGORY, O'BRIEN, NOFS, HANSEN, BIEDA, HILDENBRAND and CONYERS and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1965 PA 203, entitled "Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act," (MCL 28.601 to 28.615) by adding section 9e.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 9E. ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2019, THE COMMISSION SHALL  
2   DEVELOP A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS  
3   REGARDING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER CONDUCT DURING A TRAFFIC STOP.  
4   THE TRAINING MUST, AT A MINIMUM, DIRECT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO  
5   STATE THEIR NAME AND RANK AT THE INITIAL CONTACT DURING A TRAFFIC  
6   STOP AND PROVIDE A BUSINESS CARD WITH THE CONTACT INFORMATION OF  
7   THE PERSON WHO WILL RECEIVE COMPLAINTS ABOUT THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT  
8   OFFICER.

9           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
10 after the date it is enacted into law.

11           Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
