SENATE BILL No. 829

February 15, 2018, Introduced by Senators O'BRIEN and JONES and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17744b (MCL 333.17744b), as amended by 2016 PA 384.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17744b. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of this act to
- 2 the contrary, a prescriber may issue a prescription for and a
- 3 dispensing prescriber or pharmacist may dispense an opioid
- 4 antagonist to any of the following:
 - (a) An individual patient at risk of experiencing an opioidrelated overdose.
 - (b) A family member, friend, or other individual in a position to assist an individual at risk of experiencing an opioid-related overdose.
 - (c) A school board for purposes of section 1179b of the

- 18 unless Senate Bill No. 828
- of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
