A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 17756 (MCL 333.17756), as amended by 1993 PA

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 17756. (1) A LABEL ON A prescription dispensed by a pharmacist shall bear upon the label the MUST INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (A) THE name of the medication in the container, unless the prescriber writes "do not label" on the prescription.
 - (B) The prescription shall also bear upon the label the following statement: "Discard this medication 1 year after the date it is dispensed.", unless the medication expires on another date under applicable state or federal law or rules or regulations or other state or federal standards. If the medication expires on

- 3 SUBDIVISION and shall specify on the label the actual expiration
