

SENATE BILL No. 1041

June 5, 2018, Introduced by Senator BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
by amending section 17756 (MCL 333.17756), as amended by 1993 PA
73.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 17756. (1) A **LABEL ON A** prescription dispensed by a
2 pharmacist ~~shall bear upon the label the~~ **MUST INCLUDE ALL OF THE**
3 **FOLLOWING:**

4 **(A) THE** name of the medication in the container, unless the
5 prescriber writes "do not label" on the prescription.

6 **(B)** The ~~prescription shall also bear upon the label the~~
7 following statement: "Discard this medication 1 year after the date
8 it is dispensed.", unless the medication expires on another date
9 under applicable state or federal law or rules or regulations or
10 other state or federal standards. If the medication expires on

1 another date, the pharmacist dispensing the prescription shall
2 strike or omit the statement required under this ~~subsection~~
3 **SUBDIVISION** and ~~shall~~ specify on the label the actual expiration
4 date of the medication.

5 (C) **THE TELEPHONE NUMBER OF A SUBSTANCE ABUSE HOTLINE.**

6 (2) A label on a prescription dispensed by a dispensing
7 prescriber ~~shall~~ **MUST** include the ~~the~~ **ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

8 (A) **THE** name of the medication in the container.

9 (B) ~~The label shall also include the~~ statement required under
10 subsection (1) or the actual expiration date of the medication in
11 the container in the same manner required under subsection (1) for
12 a prescription dispensed by a pharmacist.

13 (C) **THE TELEPHONE NUMBER OF A SUBSTANCE ABUSE HOTLINE.**

14 (3) **THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED SUBSECTIONS (1) (C) AND**
15 **(2) (C) MAY BE REFERRED TO AS THE "MEGAN LETAVIS LAW".**

16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
17 after the date it is enacted into law.
