

SENATE BILL No. 1075

September 5, 2018, Introduced by Senators WARREN, HOPGOOD and BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 5125a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 5125A. A LICENSED HEALTH PROFESSIONAL IN CHARGE OF THE
2 CARE OF A NEWBORN INFANT, OR IF NONE, THE LICENSED HEALTH
3 PROFESSIONAL IN CHARGE AT THE BIRTH OF AN INFANT, SHALL ADMINISTER
4 PROPHYLACTIC VITAMIN K TO THE INFANT THROUGH AN INTRAMUSCULAR
5 INJECTION WITHIN 1 HOUR AFTER THE BIRTH OF THE INFANT, OR AS SOON
6 AFTER THE BIRTH OF THE INFANT AS THE HEALTH PROFESSIONAL IS
7 PRESENT. IF ANY VITAMIN K DEFICIENCY BLEEDING, OR A HEMORRHAGE OF
8 UNKNOWN ETIOLOGY THAT IS NOT BETTER EXPLAINED BY ANOTHER MEDICAL
9 CAUSE, OCCURS WITHIN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE DATE OF BIRTH OF AN INFANT

1 WHO DID NOT RECEIVE AN INTRAMUSCULAR INJECTION OF PROPHYLACTIC
2 VITAMIN K, THE LICENSED HEALTH PROFESSIONAL HAVING CARE OF THE
3 INFANT SHALL REPORT THE CONDITION TO THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
5 after the date it is enacted into law.
