SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 445 would amend the Public Health Code (1978 PA 368) by extending the sunset on the annual license fee for substance use disorder programs, which will mature on October 1, 2019. The bill would maintain the FY 2018-19 fee amount by maintaining the fee (which would otherwise be eliminated) for an additional four years, through October 1, 2023.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The bill would maintain the current level of revenue collected by the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA), to the extent that LARA would continue collecting revenue generated by a fee that would otherwise sunset. Revenue generated from the fee is deposited to the Health Systems Fees Fund. An estimate made using data provided by the State Budget Office indicates that resulting revenue loss if the sunset is not extended would total approximately \$593,000.
