**Overview**

Senate Bill 748 (H-3) contains supplemental appropriation adjustments for the Departments of Labor and Economic Opportunity and State for FY 2020-21. Adjustments increase Gross appropriations by \$5.0 million and GF/GP appropriations by \$0.

Appropriation and boilerplate priorities initiated by the legislature are identified following this overview.

Authorizes \$2.0 million of state restricted Contingent Fund, Penalty and Interest Account funding for establishing proper health and safety protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Local offices would open and full-time, in-person services would be maintained.	Restricted	2,000,000

<b>2. Branch Office Operations</b>	<b>Gross</b>	<b>\$3,000,000</b>
Authorizes \$3.0 million of state restricted Enhanced Driver License and Enhanced Official State Personal Identification Card Fund revenue for establishing proper health and safety protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Secretary of state branch offices would open and full-time, in-person services would be maintained at each branch office.	Restricted	3,000,000

**FY 2020-21 Supplemental Boilerplate Items**

**GENERAL SECTIONS**

**Sec. 201. State Spending and State Appropriations Paid to Local Units of Government**

Estimates total state spending from state sources and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government.

**Sec. 202. Appropriations Subject to Management and Budget Act**

Subjects appropriations and expenditures to the Management and Budget Act, 1984 PA 431.

**Sec. 203. State Administrative Board Transfers**

Authorizes the legislature, by a concurrent resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and serving in each house, to intertransfer funds if the State Administrative Board transfers funds from an amount appropriated.

**FY 2020-21 Supplemental Boilerplate Items**

**LABOR AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY**

***Sec. 351. Unemployment Insurance Agency Operations***

Requires the Unemployment Insurance Agency to allocate not less than \$2.0 million to establish proper health and safety protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19 by December 1, to ensure full-time, in-person services at the 12 existing unemployment insurance local offices are maintained, and to not require individuals to schedule appointments to receive in-person services after November 30; authorizes in-person services by appointment if requested by individuals.

**STATE**

***Sec. 401. Branch Office Operations***

Requires the Department of State to allocate not less than \$3.0 million to establish proper health and safety protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19 by December 1, to ensure full-time, in-person services at each secretary of state branch office are maintained, and to not require individuals to schedule appointments to receive in-person services after November 30; authorizes in-person services by appointment if requested by individuals.
