SUMMARY:

House Bill 5977 would amend 1973 PA 116, the child care licensing act, to provide that a child care center, group child care home, or family child care home that is subject to a rule promulgated under the act has at least 90 days after the rule is promulgated to come into compliance with it.

MCL 722.112

House Bill 5977 would not have an appreciable fiscal impact on any unit of state or local government.
