SUMMARY:

House Bill 6493 would amend Article 17 (Facilities and Agencies) of the Public Health Code to allow an employee or volunteer at a health facility or agency to assist with feeding or transporting a patient or resident in accordance with the patient's or resident's plan of care if instructed to do so by a supervising health professional.

However, this would not apply to an ambulance operation, aircraft transport operation, nontransport prehospital life support operation, or medical first response service.

The bill's provisions would be repealed 120 days after taking effect.
