A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 552b (MCL 750.552b), as added by 1996 PA 232.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 552b. (1) A person who willfully trespasses by entering or remaining upon on the property of a state correctional facility without authority or permission to enter or remain is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 4 years or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
 - (2) As used in this section, "state correctional facility"

- 1 means a facility or institution that houses a prisoner population
- 2 under the jurisdiction of the department of corrections or that is
