March 19, 2019, Introduced by Senators LASATA, BARRETT, NESBITT, VICTORY, BUMSTEAD, DALEY, HORN, STAMAS, MACDONALD, THEIS, OUTMAN, MCBROOM, LAUWERS, LUCIDO, ZORN, BIZON, RUNESTAD, VANDERWALL and MACGREGOR and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.
