

# HOUSE BILL NO. 4690

June 05, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Hope, Wittenberg, Elder, Pagan, Brixie, Kuppa, Anthony and Gay-Dagnogo and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms and electro-muscular disruption devices under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe

certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

(MCL 28.421 to 28.435) by adding section 2c.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 2c. (1) A recognized target range or shooting facility  
2 shall not rent, lease, or loan a firearm to an individual unless  
3 the target range or shooting facility has verified 1 of the  
4 following:

5           (a) That the individual is not prohibited under federal law  
6 from possessing a firearm by performing a background check through  
7 the federal National Instant Criminal Background Check System.

8           (b) That the individual is licensed to carry a concealed  
9 pistol under section 5b.

10           (c) That the individual has a valid license issued under  
11 section 2.

12           (2) A recognized target range or shooting facility that  
13 violates subsection (1), or whose employee violates subsection (1),  
14 is responsible for a state civil infraction and may be ordered to  
15 pay a civil fine of not more than \$500.00.
