

HOUSE BILL NO. 4800

June 26, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Cherry, Sneller, Ellison, Hood, Gay-Dagnogo, Yaroach and Coleman and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
by amending section 810 (MCL 257.810), as amended by 2003 PA 152.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 810. **(1)** Except as otherwise provided **in subsection (2)**
2 **or another section of this act**, all fees received and money
3 collected under sections 801 to 809 ~~shall~~**must** be deposited in the
4 state treasury and ~~shall~~**must** be credited to the Michigan



1 transportation fund.

2 (2) The first \$40.00 of each vehicle registration tax
3 collected from a registrant for a vehicle registered under section
4 801(1) (p) must be deposited in the general fund in a restricted
5 account and distributed, upon appropriation, to the city, village,
6 or township in which the registrant resides. If the amount of the
7 vehicle registration tax collected from that registrant is less
8 than \$40.00, the secretary of state must not deposit more than the
9 amount collected. Money in the restricted account at the end of a
10 fiscal year must remain in the restricted account and must not
11 lapse to the general fund. A city, village, or township shall use
12 the money received under this subsection for the repair and
13 maintenance of highways or streets within that city, village, or
14 township. A township may use the money received under this
15 subsection to match money expended by a county or county road
16 commission on highways or streets within the township. As used in
17 this subsection, "county road commission" means that term as
18 defined in section 10c of 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.660c.

19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
20 after the date it is enacted into law.
