A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 602d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 602d. (1) An individual shall not operate a motor vehicle while a dog is sitting in his or her lap, unless the dog is sitting in his or her lap for a medical purpose under the Americans with disabilities act of 1990, 42 USC 12101 to 12213.
- 5 (2) An individual who violates subsection (1) is responsible 6 for a civil infraction and shall be ordered to pay a civil fine as





1 follows:

- 2 (a) For a first violation, \$100.00.
- 3 (b) For a second or subsequent violation, \$200.00.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
