

HOUSE BILL NO. 5380

January 23, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Slagh and Hernandez and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to provide for a capital outlay program and for certain other state departments; to set forth the provisions for its implementation within the budgetary process; to make appropriations for planning and construction at state institutions and the acquisition of land; to provide for the elimination of fire hazards at the institutions; to provide for certain special maintenance, remodeling, alteration, renovation, or demolition of and additions to projects at state institutions; to provide for elimination of occupational safety and health hazards at state agencies and institutions; to provide for the award of contracts; and to provide



for the expenditure of certain appropriations under the supervision of the director of the department of technology, management, and budget and the state administrative board.
