A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 227 (MCL 750.227), as amended by 1986 PA 8.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 227. (1) A person shall not carry a dagger, dirk,
- 2 stiletto, a double-edged nonfolding stabbing instrument of any
- 3 length, or any other dangerous weapon, except a hunting or fishing
- 4 knife adapted and carried as such, a hunting or fishing knife,
- 5 concealed on or about his or her person, or whether concealed or
- 6 otherwise in any vehicle operated or occupied by the person, except





- in his or her dwelling house, place of business or on other landpossessed by the person.
- 3 (2) A person shall not carry a pistol concealed on or about
 4 his or her person, or, whether concealed or otherwise, in a vehicle
 5 operated or occupied by the person, except in his or her dwelling
- 6 house, place of business, or on other land possessed by the person,
- 7 without a license to carry the pistol as provided by law and if
- 8 licensed, shall not carry the pistol in a place or manner
- 9 inconsistent with any restrictions upon such that license.
- 10 (3) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony, 11 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years, or by a fine 12 of not more than \$2,500.00.
