## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5542**

February 25, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Calley and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17211 (MCL 333.17211), as amended by 2017 PA  $^{22}$ .

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 17211. (1) An individual shall not engage in the practice of nursing or the practice of nursing as a licensed practical nurse unless he or she is licensed or is otherwise authorized by this
- 4 article.
- 5 (2) The following words, titles, or letters or a combination





- 1 of the words, titles, or letters, with or without qualifying words
- 2 or phrases, are restricted in use only to those persons individuals
- 3 authorized under this part to use the terms and in a way prescribed
- 4 in this part:
- 5 (a) "Registered professional nurse", "registered nurse",
- 6 "nurse", "r.n.", "licensed practical nurse", "l.p.n.", "nurse
- 7 midwife", "certified nurse midwife", "c.n.m.", "advanced practice
- 8 registered nurse", "a.p.r.n.", "nurse anesthetist", "nurse
- 9 practitioner", "n.p.", "certified nurse practitioner", and
- 10 "c.n.p.".
- 11 (b) Beginning 12 months after the effective date of the rules
- 12 promulgated under section 17210(2), March 8, 2019, "clinical nurse
- 13 specialist", "c.n.s.", "clinical nurse specialist-certified", and
- **14** "c.n.s.-c.".
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 16 after the date it is enacted into law.
