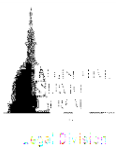

8 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

9 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

10 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state  
 11 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under  
 12 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 is \$0.00 and  
 13 total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units  
 14 of government is \$0.00.

15 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized  
 16 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,  
 17 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are  
 18 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101  
 19 to 18.1594.

21 **DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND ECONOMIC GROWTH**

22 Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for unemployment  
 23 insurance agency shall be used by the unemployment insurance agency  
 24 to create and operate a loan program for individuals who have  
 25 applied for but have not received unemployment benefits during the  
 26 COVID-19 pandemic as determined by the unemployment insurance  
 27 agency. The unemployment insurance agency shall automatically  
 28 collect loan repayments from benefits payed to claimants. The loan  
 29 program shall provide for collection procedures if an individual



1 receives a loan under the loan program and is determined not to be  
2 eligible for unemployment benefits.

3 (2) The unemployment insurance agency shall work with the  
4 department of treasury as needed to assist in implementation of the  
5 loan program and in collecting loan payments. The unemployment  
6 insurance agency shall provide a report to the legislature not  
7 later than October 31st, 2020 on the results of the loan program.
