Beginning with the first appointment after the effective date of the 2020 act that amended this section, at least 1 of the appointive members shall be a resident of a county with a population of less than 100,000.
  - (3) The terms of the term of an appointive members shall be member is 4 years, except that of those first appointed, 1 shall be appointed for 1 year, 1 shall be appointed for 2 years, and 1 shall be appointed for 3 years.
