9 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

10 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

11 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state  
 12 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under  
 13 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 is \$0.00 and  
 14 total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units  
 15 of government is \$0.00.

16 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized  
 17 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,  
 18 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are  
 19 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101  
 20 to 18.1594.

 22 **DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY**

23 Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for the  
 24 unemployment insurance agency shall be used by the unemployment  
 25 insurance agency to provide restitution to individuals who applied  
 26 for unemployment insurance benefits, waited 6 weeks or more for the  
 27 processing of their claim, and, as a result of the delay, incurred  
 28 fees, interest, or other financial penalties due to not being  
 29 processed through the unemployment insurance agency in a timely



1 manner. The unemployment insurance agency shall notify individuals  
2 potentially eligible to receive restitution funding of the  
3 availability of funding and of how to apply to receive restitution  
4 funding. As part of the application process, the unemployment  
5 insurance agency may require individuals to provide documentation  
6 as proof of costs incurred.

7 (2) The unemployment insurance agency shall provide a monthly  
8 report to the senate and house appropriations committees, the  
9 senate and house fiscal agencies, and the state budget office that  
10 includes the number of applications received and the amounts  
11 awarded.

12 (3) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for the  
13 unemployment insurance agency are designated as a work project  
14 appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse  
15 at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for  
16 expenditures for projects under this section until the projects  
17 have been completed. The following is in compliance with section  
18 451a(1) of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL  
19 18.1451a:

20 (a) The purpose of the work project is to provide restitution  
21 to individuals who applied for unemployment insurance benefits,  
22 waited 6 weeks or more for the processing of their claim, and, as a  
23 result of the delay, incurred fees, interest, or other financial  
24 penalties.

25 (b) The projects will be accomplished by utilizing state  
26 employees or by contracts.

27 (c) The total estimated cost of the work project is  
28 \$50,000,000.00.

29 (d) The tentative completion date is December 30, 2020.
