

HOUSE BILL NO. 6027

July 23, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Sabo and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 43537 (MCL 324.43537), as amended by 2013 PA 108.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 43537. (1) ~~Until March 1, 2014, a resident who is~~
2 ~~declared legally blind is eligible to purchase a senior restricted~~
3 ~~or senior all-species fishing license. Beginning March 1, 2014, a~~ **A**
4 resident who is declared legally blind is eligible to purchase a
5 senior all-species fishing license.

1 (2) A disabled veteran is eligible to obtain any resident
2 license under this part for which a lottery is not required free of
3 charge.

4 (3) **An individual with a developmental disability may obtain**
5 **an all-species fishing license free of charge.**

6 (4) ~~(3)~~—The department may demand proof of eligibility under
7 subsection (1), (2), or ~~(4)~~.—(3). The licensee, when taking aquatic
8 species or hunting, shall possess proof of his or her eligibility
9 under subsection (1), (2), or ~~(4)~~,—(3), as applicable, and shall
10 furnish the proof upon the request of a peace officer.

11 (5) ~~(4)~~—The department shall process licenses issued under
12 this section in the same manner as licenses issued to senior
13 citizens for purposes of receiving appropriations from the
14 legislature under section 43546.

15 (6) ~~(5)~~—As used in this section: ~~,"disabled~~

16 (a) **"Developmental disability" means that term as defined in**
17 **section 100a of the mental health code, 1974 PA 258, MCL 330.1100a.**

18 (b) **"Disabled veteran" means either of the following:**

19 (i) ~~(a)~~—A resident who has been determined by the United States
20 ~~department~~—**Department** of ~~veterans affairs~~—**Veterans Affairs** to be
21 permanently and totally disabled as a result of military service
22 and entitled to veterans' benefits at the 100% rate, for a
23 disability other than blindness.

24 (ii) ~~(b)~~—A resident rated by the United States ~~department~~
25 **Department** of ~~veterans affairs~~—**Veterans Affairs** as individually
26 unemployable.

27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
28 after the date it is enacted into law.
