## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6204**

September 15, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Eisen, LaFave, Markkanen, Wozniak, Paquette, Yaroch, Meerman, Griffin, Mueller, Hoitenga, Afendoulis and Shannon and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 528b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 528b. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person
- 2 who assaults, by doing either of the following, a first responder
- 3 who is discharging or attempting to discharge his or her duties
- 4 during a riot or civil disturbance is guilty of a felony punishable
- 5 by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or a fine of not more
- 6 than \$5,000.00, or both:





- 1 (a) Knowingly causing bodily injury to a first responder.
- 2 (b) Knowingly causing physical contact with a first responder
- 3 that a reasonable person would regard as extremely offensive or
- 4 provocative, including, but not limited to, spitting, throwing, or
- 5 otherwise transferring bodily fluids, bodily pathogens, or human
- 6 waste onto a first responder.
- 7 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) resulting in or
- 8 involving any of the following is guilty of a felony punishable by
- 9 imprisonment for not more than 20 years or a fine of not more than
- 10 \$20,000.00, or both:
- 11 (a) A serious bodily injury to a first responder.
- 12 (b) The death of a first responder.
- 13 (c) The use or display of a deadly weapon.
- 14 (d) The strangulation or attempted strangulation of a first
- 15 responder.
- 16 (3) As used in this section:
- 17 (a) "Emergency medical technician" means that term as defined
- 18 in section 20904 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 19 333.20904.
- 20 (b) "Firefighter" means that term as defined in section 2 of
- 21 the firefighters training council act, 1966 PA 291, MCL 29.362.
- (c) "First responder" means a firefighter, a law enforcement
- 23 officer, an emergency medical technician, or a paramedic.
- 24 (d) "Law enforcement officer" means that term as defined in
- 25 section 2 of the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards
- 26 act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.602.
- 27 (e) "Paramedic" means that term as defined in section 20908 of
- 28 the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20908.
- 29 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
