

# HOUSE BILL NO. 6247

September 22, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Hope, Greig, Wittenberg, Brenda Carter and Rabhi and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 268, entitled  
"Legislative council act,"  
by amending section 104a (MCL 4.1104a), as amended by 2013 PA 241.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 104a. (1) The council shall appoint a council  
2 administrator who ~~shall be~~**is** the chief executive officer of all  
3 legislative council agencies. The council administrator is an at-  
4 will employee and ~~shall serve~~**serves** at the pleasure of the  
5 council. The council administrator has all the following duties and  
6 responsibilities:



1 (a) To provide general supervisory oversight over all  
2 legislative council agencies.

3 (b) To provide personnel policy oversight and development for  
4 all legislative council agencies.

5 (c) To develop, prepare, and present legislative council  
6 agency budgets.

7 (d) To review quarterly financial statements of legislative  
8 council agencies and monitor budgetary compliance.

9 (e) To act as secretary to the council, including but not  
10 limited to the following:

11 (i) Scheduling of meetings for the council and subcommittees.

12 (ii) Keeping and recording of minutes and records of meetings.

13 (f) To perform other duties and responsibilities as determined  
14 and assigned by the council.

15 (2) In addition to the responsibilities provided in subsection  
16 (1), ~~at the direction of the Michigan state capitol commission,~~ the  
17 council administrator shall do both of the following **for the**  
18 **employees of the council described under section 6 of the Michigan**  
19 **state capitol historic site act, 2013 PA 240, MCL 4.1946:**

20 (a) Administer compensation, benefits, and other personnel  
21 support. ~~for the employees of the Michigan state capitol~~  
22 ~~commission.~~

23 (b) Administer computer, telephone, and technical support. ~~for~~  
24 ~~employees of the Michigan state capitol commission.~~

25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
26 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 6246 (request no.  
27 06877'20) of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
