## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6263**

September 24, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Mueller, Calley, LaGrand, Whiteford, Afendoulis, Brann and Marino and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure,"

by amending section 27c of chapter VIII (MCL 768.27c), as added by 2006 PA 79.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 CHAPTER VIII
2 Sec. 27c. (1) Evidence of a statement by a declarant is
3 admissible if all of the following apply:





- (a) The statement purports to narrate, describe, or explain the infliction or threat of physical injury upon the declarant.
- 3 (b) The action in which the evidence is offered under this
  4 section is an offense involving domestic violence, prostitution, or
  5 human trafficking.
- 6 (c) The statement was made at or near the time of the
  7 infliction or threat of physical injury. Evidence of a statement
  8 made more than 5 years before the filing of the current action or
  9 proceeding is inadmissible under this section.
- 10 (d) The statement was made under circumstances that would 11 indicate the statement's trustworthiness.
  - (e) The statement was made to a law enforcement officer.
- 13 (2) For the purpose of subsection (1)(d), circumstances
  14 relevant to the issue of trustworthiness include, but are not
  15 limited to, all of the following:
- (a) Whether the statement was made in contemplation of pendingor anticipated litigation in which the declarant was interested.
  - (b) Whether the declarant has a bias or motive for fabricating the statement, and the extent of any bias or motive.
  - (c) Whether the statement is corroborated by evidence other than statements that are admissible only under this section.
  - (3) If the prosecuting attorney intends to offer evidence under this section, the prosecuting attorney shall disclose the evidence, including the statements of witnesses or a summary of the substance of any testimony that is expected to be offered, to the defendant not less than 15 days before the scheduled date of trial or at a later time as allowed by the court for good cause shown.
- (4) Nothing in this section shall be construed to abrogate anyprivilege conferred by law.

- 2 (a) "Declarant" means a person who makes a statement.
- 3 (b) "Domestic violence" or "offense involving domestic
- 4 violence" means an occurrence of 1 or more of the following acts by

- (i) A spouse or former spouse.
- 18 (ii) An individual with whom the person resides or has resided.
- (iii) An individual with whom the person has or has had a child

- (iv) An individual with whom the person has or has had a dating
- 22 relationship. As used in this subparagraph, "dating relationship"
- 23 means frequent, intimate associations primarily characterized by
- 24 the expectation of affectional involvement. This term does not
- 25 include a casual relationship or an ordinary fraternization between
- 26 2 individuals in a business or social context.
- 27 (d) "Human trafficking" means a violation of chapter LXVIIA of
- 28 the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.462a to 750.762h.
- 29 (e) "Prostitution" means a violation of chapter LXVII of the

- 1 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.448 to 750.462.
- 2 (6) This section applies to trials and evidentiary hearings
- 3 commenced or in progress on or after May 1, 2006.
