HOUSE BILL NO. 6328

November 10, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Steven Johnson and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 82118 (MCL 324.82118), as amended by 2010 PA 371.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 82118. (1) In addition to registration of a snowmobile under section 82105 or registration in another state or province, except as otherwise provided in this section, a person who desires to operate a snowmobile in this state shall purchase a Michigan

- 1 snowmobile trail permit sticker. The Michigan snowmobile trail
- 2 permit issued under this section shall must be valid for a period
- 3 of 1 year which that begins on October 1 and ends on the following
- 4 September 30. The fee for the permit shall must be as follows:

- 6 1, 2009 or October 1, 2010, \$35.00.
- 7 (b) For permits valid for the 1-year period beginning October

- 6 (4) The trail permit sticker shall must be permanently affixed
 7 to the snowmobile directly above or below the headlight of the
 8 snowmobile.
- 9 (5) The department may contract with a person to act as an 10 agent for the purpose of issuing Michigan snowmobile trail permits. 11 The department shall sell the permits to agents in bulk. An agent 12 may obtain a refund from the department for any permits that are 13 not sold.
- 14 (6) An agent who uses or allows the use of a permit by anyone 15 except the snowmobile user to whom the permit is sold is guilty of 16 a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of \$50.00 for each instance of 17 such—use or allowed use.

- (7) The department of state may suspend a certificate of registration if the department of state determines that the required fee has not been paid and remains unpaid after reasonable notice or demand. In addition to the required fee, a \$10.00 penalty shall must be assessed and collected against any person who tenders an insufficient check or draft in payment of the fee.
 - (8) A snowmobile used solely for transportation on the frozen surface of public waters for the purpose of ice fishing is exempt from the requirement of purchasing and displaying a snowmobile trail permit sticker under this section.
- (9) A person shall not charge a fee for a snowmobile trailpermit in an amount that is greater than the fee printed on the

- 2 (10) To obtain a snowmobile trail permit, an applicant shall
- 3 provide all information required on the permit application.
- 4 (11) A person who fails to secure a permit under this section
- 5 or who violates subsection (4) is responsible for a state civil
- 6 infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of not more than
- **7** \$100.00.
- 8 (12) The department shall, by June 1 of each year, report to
- 9 the members of the appropriate standing committees and
- 10 appropriations subcommittees of the house and senate, a detailed
- 11 expenditure plan pertaining to the additional funds generated by
- 12 this act. section. The plan shall must include information as to
- 13 how funds were expended in the prior year.
- 14 (13) This section does not apply to a historic snowmobile
- 15 registered under section 82105c.
- 16 (14) Before the start of each snowmobile season, the
- 17 department shall designate 1 weekend in that snowmobile season
- 18 during which a trail permit under this section is not required.
