

HOUSE BILL NO. 6411

November 12, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Bolden, Meerman, Coleman and Steven Johnson and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 200, entitled

"An act to regulate driveways, banners, events, and parades upon and over highways; to provide for the promulgation of rules; to prescribe requirements for the issuance of permits; and to provide for the issuance of those permits,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 247.325).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5. The **state transportation** department ~~of state highways~~
2 shall make rules necessary for the administration of this act ~~in~~

1 ~~accordance with the provisions of Act No. 88 of the Public Acts of~~
2 ~~1943, as amended, being sections 24.71 to 24.80 of the Compiled~~
3 ~~Laws of 1948, and subject to Act No. 197 of the Public Acts of~~
4 ~~1952, as amended, being sections 24.101 to 24.110 of the Compiled~~
5 ~~Laws of 1948. The boards~~ **as provided in the administrative**
6 **procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328. A board**
7 of county road commissioners may adopt by reference the rules, in
8 whole or in part, of the **state transportation** department ~~of state~~
9 ~~highways~~ or may adopt its own rules after a public hearing of which
10 notice has been given **as provided in this section. Before January**
11 **1, 2022, notice of a hearing under this section must be provided** by
12 publication at least twice in a newspaper circulated in the county
13 not more than 30 days nor less than 7 days ~~prior to~~ **before** the
14 hearing. **Beginning January 1, 2022, notice of a hearing under this**
15 **section must be posted as provided in the local government public**
16 **notice act.**
