

# SENATE BILL NO. 215

March 14, 2019, Introduced by Senator JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 6a of chapter V (MCL 765.6a).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

CHAPTER V

2       Sec. 6a. ~~Before granting an application for bail, a court~~  
3 ~~shall require a cash bond or a surety other than the applicant if~~

5       ~~(1) Is charged with a crime alleged to have occurred while on~~

4 **financial status on the financial disclosure form described in**

6 **may be punished as provided in section 1715 of the revised**  
7 **judicature act of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.1715.**

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
9 after the date it is enacted into law.

10 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
11 unless all of the following bills of the 100th Legislature are  
12 enacted into law:
