Rep. Sheppard introduced

House Bill No. 5313, entitled

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled “Michigan vehicle code,” by amending section 801 (MCL 257.801), as amended by 2019 PA 88.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

Reps. Markkanen, Paquette, Bellino and LaFave introduced

House Bill No. 5314, entitled

A bill to amend 1909 PA 283, entitled “An act to revise, consolidate, and add to the laws relating to the establishment, opening, discontinuing, vacating, closing, altering, improvement, maintenance, and use of the public highways and private roads; the condemnation of property and gravel therefor; the building, repairing and preservation of bridges; maintaining public access to waterways under certain conditions; setting and protecting shade trees, drainage, and cutting weeds and brush within this state; providing for the election or appointment and defining the powers, duties, and compensation of state, county, township, and district highway officials; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,” by amending section 10 of chapter IV (MCL 224.10), as amended by 2004 PA 516.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled “The insurance code of 1956,” by amending section 2213b (MCL 500.2213b), as amended by 2016 PA 276.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled “An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices; to prohibit

the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms and electro-muscular disruption devices under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,” by amending sections 1, 2, 2b, 6, 12, and 14a (MCL 28.421, 28.422, 28.422b, 28.426, 28.432, and 28.434a), sections 1 and 6 as amended by 2017 PA 95, section 2 as amended by 2015 PA 200, section 2b as amended by 2014 PA 205, section 12 as amended by 2010 PA 209, and section 14a as added by 2010 PA 295, and by adding section 2c; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled “Michigan military act,” (MCL 32.501 to 32.851) by adding section 203.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

House Bill No. 5321, entitled

A bill to amend 1998 PA 386, entitled “Estates and protected individuals code,” by amending sections 2103, 2104, 2114, 2502, 2504, 2707, 3406, 3715, 3908, 3957, 7817, and 7821 (MCL 700.2103, 700.2104, 700.2114, 700.2502, 700.2504, 700.2707, 700.3406, 700.3715, 700.3908, 700.3957, 700.7817, and 700.7821), section 2114 as amended by 2012 PA 160, section 2504 as amended by 2009 PA 46, section 3715 as amended by 2018 PA 14, and sections 7817 and 7821 as amended by 2010 PA 325, and by adding sections 1215, 1216, 1217, 2810, and 2811 and part 1A of article II; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Families, Children, and Seniors.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 288, entitled “Probate code of 1939,” by amending section 60 of chapter X (MCL 710.60), as amended by 2006 PA 352.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," (MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 9127.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending sections 20a and 36 of chapter VIII (MCL 768.20a and 768.36), as amended by 2014 PA 76, and by adding sections 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, and 51 to chapter VIII.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1974 PA 258, entitled "Mental health code," by amending a division heading of chapter 10 and section 1050 (MCL 330.2050); and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

House Bill No. 5327, entitled

A bill to amend 1939 PA 288, entitled "Probate code of 1939," by amending section 17 of chapter XIIA (MCL 712A.17), as amended by 1998 PA 474.
