SCHOOL AID

1. Authorization of Emergency Assistance for Non-Public Schools (EANS) Program (Sec. 11o) – NEW

Authorizes \$86.8 million federal Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund for the EANS Program as designated under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act and \$93.0 million federal for the EANS Program as designated under the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act. The EANS Program provides services and assistance to nonpublic schools through a grant application process administered by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE).

2. ESSER Formula Grants Increase (Sec. 11r(4) & (8))

Increases by \$840.7 million federal Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund under the CRRSA Act (also known as ESSER II) for a total of \$1.5 billion and provides \$3.3 billion federal ESSER Fund under the ARP Act (also known as ESSER III) for formula grants required to be distributed to districts based on districts' Title I, Part A allocations. Districts may use funds only as designated under federal law, including that 20% of ESSER III grants under the ARP Act must be reserved to address learning loss. Provides that the increase in funding under these subsections is only authorized if House Bill 4082 takes effect within 14 days after being presented to the governor. HB 4082 would modify requirements for state administrative board transfers.

3. ESSER III Per-Pupil Equalization (Sec. 11r(10)) – NEW

Provides \$362.0 million federal ESSER III Fund under the ARP Act for districts that receive less than \$1,093 per pupil through the ESSER III formula grants under Sec. 11r(6). Payments are equal to the district's pupil membership multiplied by the difference between \$1,093 and the district's ESSER III formula payment per pupil. In accordance with requirements under the ARP Act, requires districts to dedicate 50.0% of funds for activities to address learning loss, 10.3% for the implementation of summer enrichment programs, and 10.3% for the implementation of after-school programs. Provides that funding under this subsection is only authorized if House Bill 4082 takes effect within 14 days after being presented to the governor.

4. ESSER II Administrative Funding Increase (Sec. 11r(11))

Increases by \$5.5 million for a total of \$8.3 million federal ESSER II Fund under the CRRSA Act for MDE to administer the grants under Sec. 11r. Provides that the increase in funding under this subsection is only authorized if House Bill 4082 takes effect within 14 days after being presented to the governor.

5. Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Systems (Sec. 11f) – NEW

Provides \$45.0 million federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund under the ARP Act for grants to districts to update their HVAC systems. Requires MDE to give higher priority to districts that will receive the least amount of ESSER II Fund under the CRRSA Act and ESSER III Fund under the ARP Act and districts that will implement a balanced calendar instructional program in at least one school beginning with the 2021-22 school year. Caps grants at \$5.0 million.

6. Summer Programming (Sec. 23d) – NEW

Provides \$10.0 million federal GEER Fund under the CRRSA Act for parents or legal guardians whose child(ren) are enrolled in summer programming in 2021. An eligible parent or guardian receives \$50 per enrolled child plus reimbursement for expenses incurred, not to exceed an additional \$200 per child. Payments may be prorated if funds are insufficient.

7. Attendance Recovery (Sec. 25i)

Increases by \$4.0 million federal ESSER III Fund under the ARP Act for a total of \$6.0 million Gross (\$2.0 million GF/GP) for an attendance recovery program for all districts that opt in to serve eligible students. Provides that the increase in funding under this section is only authorized if House Bill 4082 takes effect within 14 days after being presented to the governor.

8. Adolescent Health Centers (Sec. 31a(7))

Increases the allocation for primary health care services for children and adolescents up to age 21 by \$20.0 million federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund under the ARP Act for a total of \$28.0 million Gross (\$0 GF/GP).

COMMUNITY COLLEGES

9. Postsecondary Remediation Programs – NEW

Provides \$5.0 million federal ESSER III Fund under the ARP Act for no-cost remediation programs at community colleges for 2020 and 2021 high school graduates, and would begin prior to the start of the Fall 2021 semester. Funds would be allocated to each community college based on reported FY 2019-20 student headcount.

10. Grand Rapids Community College FastTrack Program – NEW

Provides \$1.0 million federal ESSER III Fund under the ARP Act to Grand Rapids Community College for its FastTrack program, a program that assists incoming students with below college readiness skills in English and math.
