SUMMARY:

House Bills 4494 and 4495 would add a new section to the Occupational Code and the Skilled Trades Regulation Act, respectively, to prohibit the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) from selling or furnishing any list of information obtained under either act that contains a personal phone number or email address of a licensee or registrant for the purpose of surveys, marketing, and solicitation.
