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FOOD STAMP WORK REQUIREMENTS

House Bill 5461 as reported from committee

SUMMARY:

House Bill 5461 would amend the Social Welfare Act to provide that, unless expressly required by federal law, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) must obtain specific authorization from the legislature before seeking, applying for, accepting, or renewing a waiver of work requirements established by the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)¹ under 7 USC 2015(o) for food assistance benefits.²
