SUMMARY:

House Bill 5613 would amend 1921 PA 2, which prescribes certain powers and duties of the State Administrative Board, to provide that the board is not allowed to transfer any funds appropriated to or deposited in the Strategic Outreach and Attraction Reserve Fund.

The Strategic Outreach and Attraction Reserve Fund would be created in the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO) by House Bill 5602 or Senate Bill 769. As passed by their respective houses, those bills are identical.

House Bill 5613 could not take effect unless either House Bill 5602 or Senate Bill 769 were also enacted.
