### SUMMARY:

House Bill 5871 would amend the Medical Marijuana Facilities Licensing Act (MMFLA) to expand the types of entities from or to which a licensed processor or licensed provisioning center is authorized to buy, sell, or transfer marijuana or marijuana-infused products. The table below shows (in italics) the changes proposed by the bill.

In addition, all transfers of marijuana from a provisioning center to a separate marijuana facility would have to be by means of a secure transporter, except for a transfer from a provisioning center to a marijuana facility that occupies the same location as the provisioning center.

<sup>1</sup> Transfers are not now included in the provisions governing processor licensees; they would be added by the bill.
