

# HOUSE BILL NO. 4189

February 09, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Whiteford and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PART 2

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

**GENERAL SECTIONS**

12           Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state  
 13 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under  
 14 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 is  
 15 \$15,000,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be  
 16 paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

17           Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized  
 18 under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions,  
 19 boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made  
 20 under this part and part 1, are subject to the management and  
 21 budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

22           Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under  
 23 section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount  
 24 appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent  
 25 resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and  
 26 serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the  
 27 particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

**DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES**

1           Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for adoption  
2 support services, the department of health and human services shall  
3 allocate \$10,000,000.00 to fund marketing programs that promote the  
4 adoption of infants and to develop factual educational information  
5 materials on adoption as an alternative to abortion. The department  
6 of health and human services shall issue a request for proposal for  
7 a contract for the development of marketing programs and  
8 information materials. The department of health and human services  
9 shall notify the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on  
10 health and human services, the senate and house fiscal agencies,  
11 and the senate and house policy offices on vendors submitting bids  
12 for the contract, vendors receiving the contract, the evaluation  
13 process, and criteria used by the department of health and human  
14 services to award the contract for marketing programs.

15           Sec. 302. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for maternal  
16 navigator pilot program, the department of health and human  
17 services must establish not less than 2 geographically diverse  
18 maternal navigator pilot programs. Eligible maternal navigator  
19 pilot program grantees must be a nonprofit counseling or other  
20 similar nonprofit service organization that promotes childbirth and  
21 alternatives to abortion. The services provided by the maternal  
22 navigator pilot programs must include, but are not limited to, all  
23 of the following:

24           (a) Referral services, and partial or full reimbursement, for  
25 counseling for victims of rape and other forms of abuse and  
26 violence that result in pregnancy.

27           (b) Referral services, and partial or full reimbursement, for  
28 specialized substance use disorder services, including residential  
29 services.

1 (c) Referral services, and partial or full reimbursement, to a  
2 hospital or health system for information and services for women of  
3 childbearing age who are seeking nutritional, prenatal, childbirth,  
4 and postnatal care and who are also in need of assistance with  
5 understanding recent advances in prenatal and postnatal medicines.

6 (d) Referral services, and partial or full reimbursement, for  
7 counseling, emotional support services, genetic counseling, and  
8 other services to individuals and couples experiencing difficulties  
9 or having genetic concerns related to pregnancy or parenting.

10 Sec. 303. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for  
11 pregnancy resource centers, the department of health and human  
12 services shall allocate \$1,500,000.00 as grants to pregnancy  
13 resource centers operating in the state. The department of health  
14 and human services shall distribute the funds equally to each  
15 pregnancy resource center, at an amount of not more than \$10,000.00  
16 each.

17 (2) As used in this act, "pregnancy resource centers" means  
18 private nonprofit organizations that promote childbirth and  
19 alternatives to abortion, provide referrals and information, and  
20 may also provide other services related to pregnancy or post-  
21 pregnancy.

22 Sec. 304. The department of health and human services shall  
23 not use state restricted funds or state general funds appropriated  
24 in part 1, or allow grantees or subcontractors to use those funds,  
25 for abortion counseling, referrals, or services, or for any  
26 activities regarding human cloning or research in which a human  
27 embryo or embryos are destroyed or discarded.

28 Sec. 305. From the funds appropriated in part 1, the  
29 department of health and human services shall submit a report by

1 June 1, 2021 to the senate and house appropriations committees, the  
2 senate and house appropriations subcommittees on health and human  
3 services, the senate and house fiscal agencies, and the senate and  
4 house policy offices on any request for proposals issued by the  
5 state for the healthy moms healthy babies program and on any  
6 healthy moms healthy babies programs that are established.

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8 **DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY**

9 Sec. 401. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for pregnant  
10 and parenting student services, \$500,000.00 is available to award  
11 grants to applicants that meet the eligibility conditions of the  
12 pregnant and parenting student services act, 2004 PA 500, MCL  
13 390.1591 to 390.1596.
