## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 801. (1) A person alleging a violation of this act may
- 2 bring a civil action for appropriate injunctive relief or damages,
- 3 or both. If a court determines that an employer violated section
- 4 202(c), the court shall award treble damages.
- 5 (2) An action commenced <del>pursuant to under</del> subsection (1) may

- 1 be brought in the circuit court for the county where the alleged
- 2 violation occurred, or for the county where the person against whom
- 3 the civil complaint is filed resides or has his or her principal

- 5 (3) A claim for an action brought under subsection (1) accrues
- 6 on the date the person alleging the violation acquires actual
- 7 knowledge of the violation.
- 8 (4) (3)—As used in subsection (1), "damages" means damages for
- 9 injury or loss caused by each violation of this act, including
- 10 reasonable attorney's fees.
- 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
