

HOUSE BILL NO. 4762

April 29, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Kahle and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 10251.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 **Sec. 10251. (1) A person that performs organ transplants in**
2 **this state shall not do any of the following in providing services**
3 **related to an organ transplant to an individual who has a**
4 **disability based solely on the individual's disability:**
5 **(a) Refuse to transplant an organ in the individual.**

1 (b) Deny the individual evaluation, referral, surgery,
2 counseling, or postoperative treatment for an organ transplant.

3 (c) Refuse to place the individual on an organ transplant
4 waiting list or lower the individual's priority on that waiting
5 list to receive an organ transplant.

6 (2) As used in this section:

7 (a) "Disability" means that term as defined in 42 USC 12102.

8 (b) "Organ" means that term as defined in section 10102.
