A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3157c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3157c. (1) This section applies to a person that does
- 2 both of the following:
- 3 (a) Renders treatment or rehabilitative occupational training
- 4 to an injured person for an accidental bodily injury covered by
- 5 personal protection insurance as described in section 3157.

- 1 (b) Submits a charge for the treatment or training for payment 2 or reimbursement by a personal protection insurer.
- 3 (2) A person described in subsection (1) shall not claim and
- 4 is not entitled to a lien against or reimbursement from any
- 5 recovery in tort by the injured person that is allowed under
- 6 section 3135 for any part of the charge for the treatment or
- 7 training, including, but not limited to, any part of the charge
- 8 that exceeds the amount payable under section 3157.
