

HOUSE BILL NO. 5268

August 17, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Calley and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 759 (MCL 168.759), as amended by 2020 PA 302.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 759. (1) Subject to **subsection (10) and** section 761(3),
2 at any time during the 75 days before a primary or special primary,
3 but not later than 8 p.m. on the day of a primary or special
4 primary, an elector may apply for an absent voter ballot. The
5 elector shall apply in person or by mail with the clerk of the
6 township or city in which the elector is registered. The clerk of a

1 city or township shall not send by first-class mail an absent voter
2 ballot to an elector after 5 p.m. on the Friday immediately before
3 the election. Except as otherwise provided in section 761(2), the
4 clerk of a city or township shall not issue an absent voter ballot
5 to a registered elector in that city or township after 4 p.m. on
6 the day before the election. An application received before a
7 primary or special primary may be for either that primary only, or
8 for that primary and the election that follows. An individual may
9 submit a voter registration application and an absent voter ballot
10 application at the same time if applying in person with the clerk
11 or deputy clerk of the city or township in which the individual
12 resides. Immediately after his or her voter registration
13 application and absent voter ballot application are approved by the
14 clerk or deputy clerk, the individual may, subject to the
15 identification requirement in section 761(6), complete an absent
16 voter ballot at the clerk's office.

17 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1) and subject
18 to **subsection (10) and** section 761(3), at any time during the 75
19 days before an election, but not later than 8 p.m. on the day of an
20 election, an elector may apply for an absent voter ballot. The
21 elector shall apply in person or by mail with the clerk of the
22 township, city, or village in which the voter is registered. The
23 clerk of a city or township shall not send by first-class mail an
24 absent voter ballot to an elector after 5 p.m. on the Friday
25 immediately before the election. Except as otherwise provided in
26 section 761(2), the clerk of a city or township shall not issue an
27 absent voter ballot to a registered elector in that city or
28 township after 4 p.m. on the day before the election. An individual
29 may submit a voter registration application and an absent voter

1 ballot application at the same time if applying in person with the
2 clerk or deputy clerk of the city or township in which the
3 individual resides. Immediately after his or her voter registration
4 application and absent voter ballot application are approved by the
5 clerk, the individual may, subject to the identification
6 requirement in section 761(6), complete an absent voter ballot at
7 the clerk's office.

8 (3) An application for an absent voter ballot under this
9 section may be made in any of the following ways:

10 (a) By a written request signed by the voter.

11 (b) On an absent voter ballot application form provided for
12 that purpose by the clerk of the city or township.

13 (c) On a federal postcard application.

14 (4) An applicant for an absent voter ballot shall sign the
15 application. Subject to section 761(2), a clerk or assistant clerk
16 shall not deliver an absent voter ballot to an applicant who does
17 not sign the application. A person shall not be in possession of a
18 signed absent voter ballot application except for the applicant; a
19 member of the applicant's immediate family; a person residing in
20 the applicant's household; a person whose job normally includes the
21 handling of mail, but only during the course of his or her
22 employment; a registered elector requested by the applicant to
23 return the application; or a clerk, assistant of the clerk, or
24 other authorized election official. A registered elector who is
25 requested by the applicant to return his or her absent voter ballot
26 application shall sign the certificate on the absent voter ballot
27 application.

28 (5) The clerk of a city or township shall have absent voter
29 ballot application forms available in the clerk's office at all

1 times and shall furnish an absent voter ballot application form to
2 anyone upon a verbal or written request. The absent voter ballot
3 application must be in substantially the following form:

4 "Application for absent voter ballot for:

10 citizen and a qualified and registered elector of the

15 election or elections as requested in this application.

28 the statements in this absent voter ballot application

3 WARNING

4 You must be a United States citizen to vote. If you are not a
5 United States citizen, you will not be issued an absent voter
6 ballot.

7 A person making a false statement in this absent voter ballot
8 application is guilty of a misdemeanor. It is a violation of
9 Michigan election law for a person other than those listed in the
10 instructions to return, offer to return, agree to return, or
11 solicit to return your absent voter ballot application to the
12 clerk. An assistant authorized by the clerk who receives absent
13 voter ballot applications at a location other than the clerk's
14 office must have credentials signed by the clerk. Ask to see his or
15 her credentials before entrusting your application with a person
16 claiming to have the clerk's authorization to return your
17 application.

4 (6) The following instructions for an applicant for an absent
5 voter ballot must be included with each application furnished an
6 applicant:

7 INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS FOR ABSENT VOTER BALLOTS

8 Step 1. After completely filling out the application, sign and
9 date the application in the place designated. Your signature must
10 appear on the application or you may not receive an absent voter
11 ballot.

12 Step 2. Deliver the application by 1 of the following methods:

13 (a) Place the application in an envelope addressed to the
14 appropriate clerk and place the necessary postage upon the return
15 envelope and deposit it in the United States mail or with another
16 public postal service, express mail service, parcel post service,
17 or common carrier.

18 (b) Deliver the application personally to the clerk's office,
19 to the clerk, or to an authorized assistant of the clerk.

20 (c) In either (a) or (b), a member of the immediate family of
21 the voter including a father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother-in-law,
22 sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, grandparent, or
23 grandchild or a person residing in the voter's household may mail
24 or deliver the application to the clerk for the applicant.

25 (d) If an applicant cannot return the application in any of
26 the above methods, the applicant may select any registered elector
27 to return the application. The person returning the application
28 must sign and return the certificate at the bottom of the
29 application.

1 (7) A person who prints and distributes absent voter ballot
2 applications shall print on the application the warning,
3 certificate of authorized registered elector returning absent voter
4 ballot application, and instructions required by this section.

5 (8) A person who makes a false statement in an absent voter
6 ballot application is guilty of a misdemeanor. A person who forges
7 a signature on an absent voter ballot application is guilty of a
8 felony. A person who is not authorized in this act and who both
9 distributes absent voter ballot applications to absent voters and
10 returns those absent voter ballot applications to a clerk or
11 assistant of the clerk is guilty of a misdemeanor.

12 (9) The absent voter ballot application of an elector who is a
13 program participant, as that term is defined in **section 3 of the**
14 **address confidentiality program act, 2020 PA 301, MCL 780.853,** is
15 confidential and not subject to disclosure under the freedom of
16 information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246.

17 **(10) Each county, city, and township clerk is prohibited from**
18 **sending an absent voter ballot application to an elector unless the**
19 **elector applies for an absent voter ballot as provided under**
20 **subsection (1) or (2) or unless the elector has requested to be**
21 **placed on a permanent absent voter application list maintained by a**
22 **city or township clerk. The secretary of state is prohibited from**
23 **sending an absent voter ballot application to an elector.**
