HOUSE BILL NO. 5305

September 21, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Bellino and Hertel and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act,"

by amending section 4ee (MCL 205.54ee), as added by 2015 PA 251.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 4ee. (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), beginning
 January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2035, a sale of data center
 equipment to the owner or operator of a qualified data center or a
 colocated business for assembly, use, or consumption in the
 operations of the qualified data center or a sale of data center

equipment to a person engaged in the business of constructing,
 altering, repairing, or improving real estate for others to the
 extent the data center equipment is to be affixed to or made a
 structural part of a qualified data center is exempt from the tax
 under this act.

6 (2) The exemption under this section only continues to apply 7 after January 1, 2022, if the numbers gathered by the local 8 economic development corporations are certified and reported to the 9 department of talent and economic development Michigan strategic 10 fund and subsequently forwarded to the department and demonstrate 11 that the qualified data centers, the colocated businesses, and the contractors of the qualified data centers, collectively, have, in 12 aggregate, established in this state at least 400 data center 13 14 industry jobs or data center industry related jobs, or a 15 combination of both, since January 1, 2016. The department of 16 talent and economic development Michigan strategic fund shall submit a report no later than April 1, 2022 related to the number 17 of data center industry jobs or data center industry related jobs 18 that have been established since January 1, 2016 to the speaker and 19 20 minority leader of the house of representatives, the majority and 21 minority leaders of the senate, and the governor. The information 22 gathered and reported under this subsection must also include 23 information regarding the wages paid for the data center industry 24 jobs and data center industry related jobs established since 25 January 1, 2016.

26 (3) The exemption under this section only continues to apply
27 after January 1, 2026, if the numbers gathered by the local
28 economic development corporations are certified and reported to the
29 department of talent and economic development Michigan strategic

fund and subsequently forwarded to the department and demonstrate 1 2 that the qualified data centers, the colocated businesses, and the 3 contractors of the qualified data centers, collectively, have, in 4 aggregate, established in this state at least 1,000 data center 5 industry jobs or data center industry related jobs, or a 6 combination of both, since January 1, 2016. The department of 7 talent and economic development Michigan strategic fund shall 8 submit a report no later than April 1, 2026 related to the number 9 of data center industry jobs or data center industry related jobs 10 that have been established since January 1, 2016 to the speaker and minority leader of the house of representatives, the majority and 11 minority leaders of the senate, and the governor. The information 12 gathered and reported under this subsection must also include 13 14 information regarding the wages paid for the data center industry 15 jobs and data center industry related jobs established since 16 January 1, 2016.

17 (4) As used in this section:

18 (a) "Affiliate" means a person that directly, or indirectly
19 through 1 or more intermediaries, controls, is controlled by, or is
20 under common control with a specified person.

(b) "Colocated business" means a person that has entered into a contract with the owner or operator of a qualified data center to use or deploy data center equipment physically located within the qualified data center for a period of 1 or more years.

(c) "Data center equipment" means only computers, servers, routers, switches, peripheral computer devices, racks, shelving, cabling, wiring, storage batteries, back-up generators, uninterrupted power supply units, environmental control equipment, other redundant power supply equipment, and prewritten computer

software used in operating, managing, or maintaining the gualified 1 data center or the business of the qualified data center or a 2 colocated business. Data center equipment also includes any 3 construction materials used or assembled under the qualified data 4 5 center's proprietary method for the construction or modification of 6 a qualified data center, including, but not limited to, building 7 materials, infrastructure, machinery, wiring, cabling, devices, 8 tools, and equipment that would otherwise be considered a fixture 9 or related equipment. Data center equipment does not include any 10 equipment owned by a third party that is used to supply the 11 qualified data center's primary power.

12 (d) "Enterprise data center" means a facility located in this13 state that meets all of the following requirements:

14

(*i*) The facility is composed of 1 or more buildings.

15 (*ii*) The facility houses data center equipment and is 16 developed, owned, and operated by an entity or any of the entity's 17 affiliates substantially for the entity's or any of the entity's 18 affiliates' own use.

19 (*iii*) The initial capital investment in the facility is at least 20 \$250,000,000.00. As used in this subparagraph, "initial capital 21 investment" means the investment in a facility in this state that 22 is in excess of any or all investment that the entity or any of the 23 entity's affiliates maintained in this state before the facility's 24 creation or expansion.

(*iv*) The entity and any of the entity's affiliates create and
maintain 30 or more qualified new jobs with wage rates exceeding
120% of the county average wage. As used in this subparagraph:

(A) "County average wage" means the average annual wage forthe county where the facility is located based on the most recent

data made available by the Michigan bureau of labor market
 information and strategic initiatives.

3 (B) "Qualified new jobs" means full-time jobs created by the 4 facility in this state that are in excess of the number of full-5 time jobs that the facility maintained in this state before the 6 facility's creation or expansion.

7 (e) "Michigan strategic fund" means the Michigan strategic
8 fund as described in the Michigan strategic fund act, 1984 PA 270,
9 MCL 125.2001 to 125.2094.

10 (f) (d) "Qualified data center" means a either of the 11 following:

12 (i) A facility composed of 1 or more buildings located in this 13 state and the facility is owned or operated by an entity engaged at 14 that facility in operating, managing, or maintaining a group of 15 networked computers or networked facilities for the purpose of 16 centralizing, or allowing 1 or more colocated businesses to 17 centralize, the storage, processing, management, or dissemination 18 of data of 1 or more other persons who is not an affiliate of the 19 owner or operator of a qualified data center or of a colocated 20 business and that entity receives 75% or more of its revenue from colocated businesses that are not an affiliate of the owner or 21 22 operator of the qualified data center.

23 (*ii*) Beginning on the effective date of the amendatory act that
24 added this subparagraph, an enterprise data center.

25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days26 after the date it is enacted into law.
