

# SENATE BILL NO. 573

June 24, 2021, Introduced by Senators OUTMAN, ANANICH, WOJNO, BULLOCK and BIZON  
and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1915 PA 31, entitled  
"Youth tobacco act,"  
(MCL 722.641 to 722.645) by adding section 1a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           **Sec. 1a. (1) A person who sells vapor products at retail shall**  
2 **not do any of the following:**

3           **(a) Advertise a vapor product to a minor or in a manner that**  
4 **violates the family smoking prevention and tobacco control act,**  
5 **Public Law 111-31.**

1 (b) Give away a free sample of a vapor product, including any  
2 component or part of the vapor product.

3 (c) Sell or distribute a vapor product without a health  
4 warning statement on the package of the vapor product.

5 (d) Display an advertisement for a vapor product that is not  
6 accompanied with a health warning statement about the vapor  
7 product.

8 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is responsible for a  
9 state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine as  
10 follows:

11 (a) For a first offense in a calendar year, not more than  
12 \$500.00.

13 (b) For a second offense in a calendar year, not more than  
14 \$1,000.00.

15 (c) For a third or subsequent offense in a calendar year, not  
16 more than \$2,500.00.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
18 unless all of the following bills of the 101st Legislature are  
19 enacted into law:
