A bill to amend 1976 PA 399, entitled "Safe drinking water act,"

by amending section 9 (MCL 325.1009), as amended by 2017 PA 91.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 9. (1) The department shall classify public water
supplies, including water treatment and distribution systems at
community supplies, with regard to size, type, location, and other
physical conditions for the purpose of establishing the skill,
knowledge, and experience that individuals need to maintain and

1 operate the systems effectively.

2 (2) The director shall appoint an advisory board of examiners which that shall assist the department in the examination of 3 individuals as to their competency to operate water treatment 4 5 systems and water distribution systems. The advisory board shall 6 make recommendations to the department relative to the 7 certification of those individuals. 8 (3) The membership of the advisory board shall consist 9 consists of 2-all of the following: 10 (a) Two certified water treatment operators. $\frac{1}{7}$ 11 (b) Two certified water distribution operators. -1(c) One superintendent or manager of a supplier of water. $\frac{1}{r-1}$ 12 (d) One representative of the administrative branch of a local 13 14 governmental agency. $\frac{1}{7}$ 15 (e) Two members of the public at large. $\frac{1}{7}$ and $\frac{1}{7}$ 16 (f) One professor of sanitary or environmental engineering at 17 a university in this state. (4) A representative of the department shall be the nonvoting 18 19 secretary for the board. 20 (5) (4) For individuals meeting the requirements, the 21 department shall issue certificates acknowledging their competency to operate a specified class of waterworks system or portion of 22 23 waterworks system. The department may suspend or revoke a 24 certificate as specified by rule. 25 (6) (5) A public water supply shall must be under the supervision of a properly certified operator as specified in the 26 27 rules.

(7) (6) Operators certified under this act shall renew their
certificates in accordance with the rules promulgated under this

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act, including mandatory continuing education or competency
demonstration.

3 (8) (7) In accordance with section 3110 of the natural 4 resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 5 324.3110, the department may conduct a program for training persons 6 individuals seeking to be certified as operators under this section 7 and shall administer operator certification programs for persons 8 individuals seeking to be certified as operators under this 9 section. Until October 1, 2021, 2025, the department may charge 10 fees for these programs in accordance with section 3110 of the 11 natural resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, 12 MCL 324.3110. The department shall transmit fees collected under 13 this section to the state treasurer for deposit into the operator 14 training and certification fund created in section 3134 of the 15 natural resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, 16 MCL 324.3134.

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
